*Ordered,* That the Legislative Research Bureau is hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation and study of licensing standards and procedures for landscape contractors. Said bureau shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before December first, nineteen hundred and eight-five.
