AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE SITE ASSIGNMENT TO PERSONS FOR CERTAIN HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any site assignment issued under Chapter 111, Section 150A or
- 2 Section 150B shall be automatically revoked if the individual com-
- 3 pany or corporation possessing such site assignment is placed under
- 4 receivership for criminal or financial reasons. In addition any indi-
- 5 vidual, company or corporation who declares bankruptcy shall also
- 6 have any site assignment in their name revoked.
