### **AN ACT FUNDING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY BY THE COMMONWEALTH.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, all deficit
- 2 expenditures of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority
- 3 shall be funded by the commonwealth so that no apportionment of
- 4 the deficit costs of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority
- 5 shall be assessed upon any city or town within the common-
- 6 wealth.
