RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE DEBT COLLECTION PRACTICES OF PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES.

1 *Resolved*, That a commission, to consist of three members of the
2 senate, five members of the house of representatives, the commis-
3 sioners of the department of public utilities, five persons who are
4 customers of public utility companies doing business in the com-
5 monwealth, and five persons to be appointed by the governor, one
6 of whom shall be a member of the bar and one of whom shall be the
7 proprietor of a business, is hereby established for the purpose of
8 making an investigation and study relative to the billing and debt
9 collection practices of public utility companies.
