AN ACT RELATIVE TO RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR REMOVAL, ETC., OF GARBAGE, ETC.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 358, Acts of 1921 (Chapter 111, Section 31B, General  
2 Laws) is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —

4 Boards of health shall, from time to time, make rules and regula-  
5 tions for the control of the removal, transportation or disposal of  
6 garbage, offal or other offensive substances.
