AN ACT RELATIVE TO SCHOOL BUS SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90, sec. 7B "Equipment and Operation of school buses",
- 2 Clause 8, "every school bus shall be equipped with a safety belt for
- 3 the operator thereof, and said operator shall securely fasten said
- 4 seat belt while transporting school pupils" shall be amended by
- 5 deleting clause 8 and inserting in its place:—
- 6 "Every school bus shall be equipped with safety belts for the
- 7 passengers and operator thereof, and said operator shall securely
- 8 fasten his or her own seat belt and make an inspection that the
- 9 passengers have securely fastened their seat belts. Any additional
- 10 costs to localities shall be borne by the Commonwealth."
