AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN PERSONS OVER SIXTY-FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The forty-first clause of section 5 of chapter 59, as appearing in
2 chapter 967 of the acts of 1977, is hereby amended by striking out
3 the word "seventieth" in lines three, six and eight and inserting in
4 place thereof, in each instance, the word "sixty-fifth", and by
5 striking out the words "seventy years of age" and inserting in place
6 thereof in each instance the word "sixty-fifth".
