### AN ACT EXPANDING THE INVESTIGATIVE POWERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2 Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following  
3 sentence: — In carrying out investigations of complaints made by  
4 employees of violations of law by employers, the department may  
5 compel by subpoena the attendance of witnesses and the produc-  
6 tion of documents.
