AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A REAL ESTATE EXEMPTION FOR THE OWNERS OF CERTAIN INSULATED DWELLINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 1 of chapter 743 of the acts of 1981, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following clause: —
- 4 Forty-ninth, Real estate upon which there is located a dwelling,
- 5 which is occupied by the owner as his domicile and which has been
- 6 insulated with a foam that has subsequently been banned, to an
- 7 amount equal to the exemption provided to the elderly, widows,
- 8 veterans or blind persons, whichever exemption is greater.
