

By Mr. Scaccia of Boston, petition of Angelo M. Scaccia that provision be made for the establishment of safety plans for public school systems in certain municipalities. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SAFETY PLANS FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amend-
2 ed by inserting after section 37K the following section: —

3 *Section 37L.* The school committee of every city, town or district
4 having a population of more than fifty thousand persons, accord-
5 ing to the latest census, shall, on the first of April in each even-
6 numbered year, submit to the secretary of the executive office of
7 public safety a safety plan for the prevention and control of crime
8 and disorderly conduct in the public schools and at all events
9 sponsored by or involving the public school system, whether or not
10 held on public school property.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on September first, nine-
2 teen hundred and eighty-four.
