AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING INJURED LEAVE TO CERTAIN POLICE AND FIREFIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 111F of chapter 41 as most recently amended by chapter
2 646 section 2 of the Acts of 1977 is hereby further amended by
3 inserting at the end of said section the following sentence: —

4 A police officer or firefighter receiving benefits under this provi-
5 sion shall not be terminated until their retirement has been granted
6 if they are unable to perform the duties as defined under this
7 section.
