By Mr. Karol of Attleboro, petition of Stephen J. Karol that income received from pensions or retirement allowances of retired members of the armed forces be exempt from the income tax. Taxation.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

AN ACT THAT INCOME RECEIVED FROM PENSIONS OR RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF RETIRED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES BE EXEMPT FROM THE INCOME TAX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Paragraph two of subsection (a) of section two of chapter sixty-
- 2 two of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section two
- 3 of chapter five hundred ninety-nine of the acts of 1977, is hereby
- 4 further amended by adding the following new subparagraph:
- 5 (G) the amount of any pension, annuity or retirement allowance
- 6 paid by the United States government to a person who has been
- 7 retired from the armed services of the United States.
