AN ACT TO CLARIFY DISTRIBUTION FROM THE LOCAL AID FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20 of Chapter 29 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by Section 58 of Chapter 367 of the Acts of
3 1978, is hereby further amended in the seventh paragraph by
4 adding the following: —

5 “The sums defined in this section under (a), (b), and (c) shall be
6 distributed to cities, towns and districts in the following way: 40%
7 of the estimated revenues shall be distributed pursuant to Chapter
8 58, Section 25A with notification to the assessors of each city and
9 town annually on or before March 1; the difference between the
10 estimated and the actual revenues in any given fiscal year shall be
11 distributed to cities, towns and districts pursuant to Chapter 58,
12 Section 25A in the next following year, in addition to 40% of the
13 revenues estimated from (a), (b), and (c) for the next following
14 fiscal year.”
