AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ALL AIR CARRIERS OPERATING REGULARLY SCHEDULED PASSENGER OR CARGO FLIGHTS SHALL REDUCE THE NUMBER OF FLIGHTS TO OR FROM LOGAN AIRPORT DURING CERTAIN HOURS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 All air carriers operating regularly scheduled passenger or cargo
2 commercial flights shall reduce the number of flights to or from
3 Logan Airport between eleven P.M. and seven A.M. which do not
4 meet the requirements of FAR Part 36 by a minimum of thirty-
5 three and one third per cent for each succeeding year, as compared
6 to the base year non-FAR Part operations, for a period of three
7 years commencing on January 1, 1979, all such flights shall meet
8 the requirements of FAR Part 36 by January nineteen hundred and
9 eighty.

All the members of the House of Representatives shall be chosen for a term of two years, and shall be eligible for re-election to the same office for one term only. The House of Representatives shall assemble at least once in every year, and the session shall begin on the first Monday in December, unless otherwise provided by law. The House of Representatives shall have the sole power of impeachment.
