### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS UPON THE USE OF SEWERS WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION JURISDICTION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The commissioner of the metropolitan district commission is  
2 hereby authorized and directed to promulgate rules and regula-  
3 tions providing for sewer bans in communities in the jurisdiction of  
4 said commission for the purpose of controlling the intake capaci-  
5 ties of the sewer lines and waste treatment plants. Said rules and  
6 regulations shall provide for public hearings to determine what the  
7 conditions of such restrictions upon the use of sewers shall be  
8 within such communities.
