In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

AN ACT TO FURTHER CLARIFY FIRE INSURANCE LOSSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 175, Section 99 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by deleting the second sentence in the seventeenth  
3 paragraph and replacing it with the following sentence: — It is  
4 moreover understood that there can be no abandonment of the  
5 property described to the company, and that the company shall  
6 not in any case be liable for more than the sum insured, with  
7 interest thereon from the time when the loss occurred, as above  
8 proved.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 175, Section 100 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following new sentence to the end  
3 of the third paragraph: — Said referee appointed by the Commis-  
4 sioner shall reside in the county where the loss to be arbitrated has  
5 occurred.

1 SECTION 3. Chapter 175, Section 101 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following new sentence to the end  
3 of the first paragraph: — Said hearing shall take place in the  
4 county where the loss being arbitrated has occurred.
