AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT APPROVED MARCH TWENTY-NINE, 1903,
RELATIVE TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PHILIPPINES

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, February 2, 1906.

That the title of the act approved March twenty-nine, 1903, be and the same be amended so that the title thereof shall read as follows:

"AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT APPROVED MARCH TWENTY-NINE, 1903,
RELATIVE TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PHILIPPINES"
