AN ACT TO EQUALIZE REGISTERS' SALARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 217 Section 35A is hereby amended as follows: —
- 2 *Section 1.* The salaries of the registers of the probate and fam-
- 3 ily court department shall be paid by the Commonwealth and shall
- 4 be as follows: Middlesex, Essex, Worcester, Norfolk, Hampden,
- 5 Bristol, Plymouth, Berkshire, Barnstable, Suffolk, Franklin,
- 6 Hampshire divisions shall be 75% of the salary of an associate
- 7 justice of the trial court.
- 8 The registers of the probate and family court department of the
- 9 Dukes and Nantucket divisions shall be 41.5% of an associate
- 10 justice of the trial court.
