

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 4096

By Mr. Cahoon of Chatham, petition of Howard C. Cahoon, Jr., for legislation to authorize certain open burning at landfill sites in all towns of Barnstable County. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

### AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN OPEN BURNING AT THE LANDFILL SITES IN ALL TOWNS OF BARNSTABLE COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one  
2 hundred and forty-two A of chapter one hundred and eleven of the  
3 General Laws, or the provisions of any other law, rule or regulation  
4 to the contrary, products of open space land husbandry and man-  
5 agement, including materials commonly referred to as brush, in-  
6 cluding vegetation such as tree branches, brush, cane, driftwood  
7 and other forestry debris, but excluding grass, hay or leaves, may  
8 be burned at the landfill sites of the towns of Barnstable County  
9 from October first to October thirty-first, both dates inclusive;  
10 provided, however, that such burning shall be performed under the  
11 supervision of the superintendent of public works, fire chief and  
12 health officer of said towns.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
