AN ACT EXEMPTING THE TWO ISLAND COUNTIES, NANTUCKET AND DUKES, FROM CONSIDERATION AS HAZARDOUS WASTE SITES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or
2 general laws to the contrary the two Island Counties of the Com-
3 monwealth, Nantucket and Dukes, shall be exempt from consider-
4 ation as Hazardous Waste Sites and none shall be constructed by
5 the Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
