AN ACT REIMBURSING THE TOWNS OF NANTUCKET AND OAK BLUFFS FROM CERTAIN EXEMPT REAL PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 2 the state treasurer shall include on the annual disbursements to the
- 3 towns of Nantucket and Oak Bluffs an amount of money to be
- 4 drawn from the Highway Fund sufficient to reimburse said towns
- 5 for any real estate taxes they would be entitled to from property of
- 6 the Woods Hole, Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket Steamship
- 7 Authority if said property were not exempt.
