### AN ACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN FIRE FIGHTING APPARATUS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The Commissioner of the Department of Corrections shall,  
2 from funds appropriated therefor, purchase a piece of fire fighting  
3 apparatus. Said apparatus shall be operated and maintained by  
4 the Town of Lancaster which shall also be responsible for garaging  
5 facilities for said vehicle. The said Commissioner shall consult  
6 with the chief of the fire department of the Town of Lancaster for  
7 advice on the type and particular component requirements of said  
8 apparatus. The total cost of said apparatus shall not exceed one  
9 hundred and eighty thousand dollars.
