AN ACT TO INCREASE BASIC INSURANCE COVERAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32A, sections 5 and 6 shall be amended to provide that
2 each employee shall be automatically insured for five thousand
3 dollars of group life insurance and five thousand dollars of acciden-
4 tal death and dismemberment insurance, with those employees
5 desiring to purchase optional coverage in excess of five thousand
6 dollars being allowed to do so as provided.
