AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO NOTIFY MUNICIPALITIES WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENALTIES FOR ILLEGAL DUMPING OF HAZARDOUS WASTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 10 of chapter 21C of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 3 The attorney general of the commonwealth shall notify each city
- 4 and town executive officer and board of health officer, of the
- 5 penalties for illegal disposition of hazardous waste, by promulgat-
- 6 ing said penalties on a yearly basis to said city and town officials.
- 7 The enforcement of this act shall be effective January first,
- 8 nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.
