### AN ACT RELATIVE TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Insert the following sentence after the first sentence of Chapter
- 2 150E, Section 7, paragraph (a): —
- 3 A successor agreement to an existing agreement shall expire no
- 4 later than three years after the expiration date of the existing
- 5 agreement.
- 6 Add the following subparagraphs to paragraph (d) of said Sec-
- 7 tion 7 of Chapter 150E: —
- 8 (r) Section 28K of Chapter 32
- 9 (s) Section 6F, the fourth paragraph of Section 28, and Section
- 10 28B of Chapter 27
- 11 (t) Sections 24A, 24B and 24C of Chapter 30.

**THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES**

As amended by the several Amendments thereto

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES, as amended, is hereby published in accordance with the Act of Congress, approved August 24, 1901, and the Act of Congress, approved August 24, 1902.

It is the duty of the President to see that the laws are faithfully executed, and he shall take care that the laws be so executed.

1. In the following sections, the words "Congress" shall mean the Congress of the United States, and the words "the President" shall mean the President of the United States.

2. A necessary and proper clause shall be inserted in each of the following sections, to wit: "and such other powers as may be necessary and proper to execute the foregoing powers."

3. Add the following sentence to the end of each of the following sections, to wit: "and such other powers as may be necessary and proper to execute the foregoing powers."

4. In section 1 of Article I, the words "and such other powers as may be necessary and proper to execute the foregoing powers" shall be inserted after the word "powers."

5. In section 2 of Article I, the words "and such other powers as may be necessary and proper to execute the foregoing powers" shall be inserted after the word "powers."

6. In section 3 of Article I, the words "and such other powers as may be necessary and proper to execute the foregoing powers" shall be inserted after the word "powers."
