AN ACT RELATING TO REPRESENTATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE IN GUN LICENSE CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 131 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by chapter 113 of the acts of 1975, is further amended by
- 3 adding after paragraph three, the following new paragraph: —
- 4 “Upon the request of the chief of police or the board or officer
- 5 having control of the police in a city or town or the Commissioner
- 6 of Public Safety or persons authorized by them, the district attorney
- 7 for the district in which the applicant or licensee resides may repre-
- 8 sent or advise the licensing authority in connection with any admin-
- 9 istrative or judicial proceedings under this section.”
