By Mr. Goyette of New Bedford, petition of Roger R. Goyette for legislation to require certain generators of hazardous waste be licensed by the Department of Environmental Quality Engineering, Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT LICENSING CERTAIN GENERATORS OF HAZARDOUS WASTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 21C of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
2 Chapter 408 of the Acts of 1980, is hereby amended by inserting
3 after Section 12 the following: all generators of regular hazardous
4 waste who produce one thousand kilograms a month, or who
5 produce and accumulate over one thousand kilograms in any
6 given year and also generators of acute hazardous waste of one
7 kilograms produced or accumulated in any month shall be licensed
8 by the Division of Hazardous Waste within the Department of
9 Environmental Quality Engineering. The amount to be charged
10 for the licenses of the various generators shall be determined by the
11 Secretary of Administration and Finance. The Division of Haz-
12 arduous Waste shall collect such fees and dispense the licenses.
