### AN ACT PROVIDING AN ADDITIONAL COURT OFFICER IN THE WORCESTER JUVENILE COURT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Clause (9) of section 62 of chapter 218 of the General  
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 729 of the acts  
3 of 1977, is hereby further amended by striking out the line reading  
4 "Worcester juvenile court".

1 SECTION 2. Clause (8) of section 62 of chapter 218 of the General  
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 565 of the acts of 1978, is  
3 hereby further amended by adding the following words: — Worcester  
4 juvenile court.
