RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO UTILIZING CERTAIN STANDARD PLANS FOR BRIDGES.

1 *Resolved*, That the commissioner of the department of public
2 works is hereby authorized and directed to make an investigation
3 and study relative to utilizing certain standard construction plans
4 for bridges. Said commissioner shall explore the feasibility of utiliz-
5 ing fill-in sheets in construction plans for bridges and post tension-
6 ing of bridges which span 18 feet to 150 feet. Said commissioner
7 shall consider the reduction in design and drafting time by utilizing
8 said fill-in sheets. Said commissioner shall report to the general
9 court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommenda-
10 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
11 said recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk
12 of the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of
13 December nineteen hundred and eighty-five.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

Article I, Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Representatives and Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.

No Person shall be a Representative who shall not, when elected, have seven Years Residence in that State, and who shall, when elected, have been seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and who shall, when elected, have attained to the Age of twenty five Years.
