RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO ACT FOR THE CURBING OF DRUG TRAFFICKING.

1 *Whereas*, The flow of controlled substances such as cocaine,
2 marijuana and heroin continues into the United States from coun-
3 tries with which the United States has existing agreements supply-
4 ing economic and military aid to said countries, and

5 *Whereas*, The elimination of such drug trafficking and the flow
6 of drugs into the United States would benefit the citizens of the
7 United States in general, and the citizens of this commonwealth, in
8 particular, therefore be it

9 *Resolved*, That the General Court of Massachusetts respect-
10 fully urges the Congress of the United States to terminate all
11 economic and military aid to countries identified by the drug
12 enforcement agencies of the federal government as sources of
13 controlled substances and sites from which such controlled sub-
14 stances are transported to or sold to persons transporting such
15 drugs to the United States, and be it further

16 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be forwarded by the
17 clerk of the house of representatives to the presiding officer of each
18 branch of the Congress and to members of each branch from the
19 commonwealth.
