AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 99A of Chapter 41 of the M.G.L. is here-
2 by amended by adding after the last sentence in the section the
3 following sentence: — The term “appointment” as used herein
4 shall not include promotions to higher grades within the same
5 police or fire departments as originally employed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
