RESOLVED PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING GUIDELINES FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF STREETS AND WAYS IN CITIES AND TOWNS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three members
2 of the senate, five members of the house of representatives, and
3 seven persons appointed by the governor, one of whom shall be the
4 commissioner of the department of public works, or his designee,
5 one of whom shall be the secretary of the department of transpor-
6 tation, or his designee, one person from the Massachusetts munic-
7 ipal association, one person from the Massachusetts taxpayers
8 foundation, one person from a recognized labor organization, one
9 person from a business organization and one person from the
10 construction industry, is hereby established for the purpose of
11 making an investigation and study relative to establishing guide-
12 lines for the management of streets and ways in cities and towns.
13 The commission, in the course of its investigation and study, shall
14 deal with the problems relative to municipal infrastructure and
15 cables, utility lines and other services affecting streets and ways.
