AN ACT REGARDING THE REPORTING OF TREATMENT FOR DOG BITES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any General Law or regulation
2 to the contrary, any person or entity who treats a victim of a dog
3 bite shall, within twenty-four hours, make a written report of same
4 to the chief of police of the municipality wherein the dog's owner
5 resides.

6 Said report shall, at a minimum, contain the name, age and
7 address of the injured party; the name and address of the owner of
8 the dog; the date and location of the incident; and a description of
9 the dog with its license number, if available.

10 Should the identity of the owner of the dog be unknown, said
11 report shall be made to the chief of police of the municipality
12 wherein the incident occurred.

1 SECTION 2. Whoever violates the notice requirement of this
2 act shall be punished by a fine of five hundred dollars.
