AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE NORFOLK COUNTY AGRICULTURAL HIGH SCHOOL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 37 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws as
2 most recently amended by Chapter 303 of the Acts of 1982 is
3 hereby further amended by inserting after the first paragraph the
4 following: —

5 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary the
6 Trustees of the Norfolk County Agricultural High School shall
7 have all the powers and duties conferred by this section and by the
8 provisions of Chapter 71 of the General Laws relating to school
9 committees of the Commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect January first, nineteen
2 hundred and eighty-five.
