AN ACT AUTHORIZING INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR STATE LOTTERY PROPERTY.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which in part is to provide at once additional revenue
3 for the commonwealth, therefore it is hereby declared to be an
4 emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the
5 public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24 of chapter 10 as inserted in the General Laws by
2 section 2 of chapter 813 of the acts of 1971 and most recently
3 amended by chapter 156 acts of 1974 is hereby further amended by
4 adding the following paragraph: —

5 Notwithstanding chapter twenty-nine of section thirty of the
6 General Laws or any similar provision, the commission shall have
7 the power to insure any property acquired pursuant to this section
8 or section twenty-six of chapter ten including, without limitation,
9 tangible or intangible personal property, computer programs,
10 game concepts, game designs, prize structures, prize pools and
11 game security.
