AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF THE BIRTHDAY OF JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 15NN the following new section: —
- 3 *Section 1500.* The governor shall annually issue a proclama-
- 4 tion setting apart the twenty-ninth day of May as John Fitzgerald
- 5 Kennedy Day and recommending that said day be observed by the
- 6 people in an appropriate manner.
