AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN TOWNS FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF PRO-VIDING POLICE OFFICERS AT POLLING PLACES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 72 of chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 Towns having a population of less than twenty-five thousand
- 4 inhabitants are exempt from the provisions of this section.
