## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF HAZARDOUS AND TOXIC WASTE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 21C of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 7 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 7A.* Every person, company, research institute or labor-
- 4 atory that generates hazardous or toxic waste shall register with the
- 5 clerk of the city or town in which he or it is located. The registration
- 6 information shall include the name and address of such individual
- 7 or company and the types and amounts of hazardous and toxic
- 8 wastes generated. Clerks of cities and towns shall forward such
- 9 information to the department. The department shall record the
- 10 type of hazardous or toxic wastes and the intended method of
- 11 disposal by the use of a computer. Each registrant shall notify the
- 12 department of the time of departure of such hazardous or toxic
- 13 waste from its facility and the time of arrival of such waste at the
- 14 disposal site.
