

HOUSE No. 6223

By Mr. Rauschenbach of Brewster, petition of Henri S. Rauschenbach for legislation to prohibit any public institution of higher education from opening for classes or registration prior to the fourth Monday in September. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT NO PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL OPEN FOR CLASSES OR REGISTRATION PRIOR TO A CERTAIN DATE IN SEPTEMBER OF EVERY YEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law or rule
2 or regulation to the contrary, no classes shall be conducted and no
3 processing of the registration, enrollment or indoctrination of stu-
4 dents shall be commenced in any public institution for higher educa-
5 tion earlier than the fourth Monday of September in each year;
6 provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not
7 apply to students taking graduate courses at such institution.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section one of this act shall not
2 be implemented prior to September of nineteen hundred and
3 eighty-seven.
