AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ADAMS TO LEASE A CERTAIN PARCEL
OF LAND TO THE ADAMS AGRICULTURAL FAIR ASSOCIATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section three of chapter forty
2 of the General Laws or any other provision of law to the contrary,
3 the town of Adams is hereby authorized to lease to the Adams
4 Agricultural Fair Association, for a period of twenty-five years, a
5 certain parcel of land, commonly known as Bowe Field, owned by
6 said town and recorded in the Northern Berkshire registry of deeds
7 in book 528, page 205.
