AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TREASURER OF ESSEX COUNTY TO PAY CERTAIN UNPAID BILLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
2 special law to the contrary, the Treasurer of Essex County is hereby
3 authorized, with the approval of the County Commissioners, to
4 pay from any available funds the sum of \$79,737.34 to the follow-
5 ing vendors for bills incurred in the past fiscal years:

1 SECTION 2. No bill shall be approved by the County Commis-
2 sioners of said County or paid by said County Treasurer thereof
3 under authority of this act, unless approved by the County Advis-
4 ory Board and until a certificate has been signed and filed with said
5 Treasurer stating under the penalties of perjury that the services for
6 which said bill was submitted were ordered by an official or
7 employee of said County and that such services were delivered and
8 actually received by said County or that such services were ren-
9 dered to said County, or both.
