AN ACT AUTHORIZING SHIRLEY DOWNY TO TAKE A CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATION FOR CORRECTIONAL OFFICER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS NOTWITHSTANDING MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law or  
2 rule to the contrary regulating the maximum age of applicants for  
3 appointment as a correctional officer in the department of correc-  
4 tions, Shirley Downy of the town of Westminster, shall be eligible  
5 to take the next open competitive examination for said correctional  
6 officer and provided she meets all other requirements, shall be  
7 eligible for certification and appointment to such position.
