RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO HAZARDOUS AND SOLID WASTES.

2 four of chapter seven hundred and four of the acts of nineteen
3 hundred and seventy-nine, and most recently revived and con-
4 tinued under the provisions of chapter one of the resolves of
5 nineteen hundred and eighty-five, shall, in the course of its investi-
6 gation and study, consider the subject matter of current house
7 document numbered 2168 encouraging the development of landfill
8 methane gas recovery facilities for use as an energy resource.
