By Mr. Hynes of Marshfield, petition of Frank M. Hynes and William B. Golden (by vote of the town) that the town of Scituate be authorized to sell and convey a certain parcel of land acquired by said town for the protection of water resources. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SCITUATE TO SELL A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Scituate, acting by and through its
2 board of selectmen is hereby authorized to sell and convey a certain
3 parcel of land acquired by said town for the protection of water
4 resources and water supply purposes.

5 Said parcel is shown as Parcel 5 on a plan entitled "Compiled
6 Plan of Land in the Town of Scituate, Massachusetts, located at
7 Driftway and Stockbridge Road", dated August 1, 1975, by Loring
8 H. Jacobs Co., recorded with Plymouth County Registry of Deeds
9 on August fifteenth, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, said Parcel
10 5 being more particularly bounded and described in an order of
11 taking dated August twelfth, nineteen hundred and seventy-five,
12 and recorded with the said Deeds on August fifteenth, nineteen
13 hundred and seventy-five, at Book 4091, Page 726. Said Parcel 5
14 containing one hundred and six acres, more or less, according to
15 said plan.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
