Ordered, That the committee on Housing and Urban Development be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject of current House document numbered 5089, legislation authorizing the Metropolitan District Commission to issue certain residential parking permits.

Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State House or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within the Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefore. Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of the investigations and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of such legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of the House on or before the first Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.
