Ordered, that a special committee of the House, consisting of three members to be appointed by the Speaker thereof, be established for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the environmental factors effecting the east central portion of Worcester County, including but not limited to the pollution of rivers, effects of acid rain and acid deposition. In the course of said investigation and study the committee shall be authorized to confer with any local groups which have been established to study such problems.

Said committee shall report to the House of Representatives the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in January, nineteen hundred and eighty-six.
