That the committee on Insurance be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject of the House Document numbered 5946 — petition for legislation to prohibit interest rates on certain motor vehicles insurance policies.

Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and findings, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday in January, nineteen eighty-six.
