The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF CERTAIN BUSINESS CORPORATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 72 of Chapter 156B of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in Section 1 of Chapter 723 of The Acts of 1964,
3 as amended by Chapter 198 of The Acts of 1967, is hereby further
4 amended by replacing the first sentence of Section 72 with a new
5 sentence to read as follows:

6 After any meeting at which any amendment of the articles of
7 organization has been adopted, articles of amendment signed
8 under the penalties of perjury by the president or any vice
9 president and by the clerk or assistant clerk, setting forth such
10 amendment and the due adoption thereof, shall be submitted to
11 the state secretary.

1 SECTION 2. Section 74 of Chapter 156B of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in Section 1 of Chapter 723 of The Acts of 1964,
3 as amended by Section 29 of Chapter 685 of The Acts of 1965,
4 as amended by Chapter 230 of The Acts of 1981, as amended by
5 Section 2 of Chapter 298 of The Acts of 1981, is hereby further
6 amended by replacing the fourth sentence of Section 74 with a
7 new sentence to read as follows:

8 After any meeting at which restated articles of organization
9 have been adopted, such restated articles, signed under the
10 penalties of perjury by the president or any vice president and by
11 the clerk or assistant clerk, shall be submitted to the state
12 secretary.

1 SECTION 3. The provisions of this Act shall be applicable to
2 articles of amendment and restated articles of organization
3 submitted to the state secretary subsequent to the effective date
4 of this Act, regardless of whether such articles of amendment or
5 restated articles were authorized or adopted at any time prior to
6 the effective date of this Act.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on its passage.
