**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CLARIFICATION OF THE FEES OF REGISTERS OF DEEDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 38 of chapter 262 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 the 1984 Official Edition, as most recently amended by chapter 515  
3 of the Acts of 1985, is hereby amended by striking out of the first  
4 and fourth paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the fol-  
5 lowing: —

6 The fees of registers of deeds, except as otherwise provided, to be  
7 paid when the instrument is left for recording, filing or deposit shall  
8 be twenty-five dollars for any papers, regardless of the number of  
9 pages, certifying the same on the original, and indexing it and for all  
10 other duties pertaining thereto, and for recording and filing any  
11 plan complying with the requirements of section 13A of chapter 36  
12 and indexing it and for all other duties pertaining thereto.
