1     *Ordered*, That the committee on Commerce and Labor shall be  
2 authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for the  
3 purpose of making an investigation and study relative to Employ-  
4 ment of Minors in the Commonwealth. The study shall be com-  
5 prised of current House document 1266.

6     Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State  
7 House or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel within  
8 the Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services  
9 and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said  
10 committee shall report to the General Court the results of its  
11 investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together  
12 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations  
13 into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of  
14 Representatives on or before the first Wednesday in December,  
15 nineteen hundred and eighty-six.
